

## Where is the Sound of - w & y ?

**Directions:** The sounds of letters w & y are two of the most difficult sounds to learn. They both make a special sound at the beginning of a word. The letter "w" makes the sound "wuh" - and "y" makes the sound "yuh" at the beginning of a word. Let's see if you can remember that. Say each picture word.
